

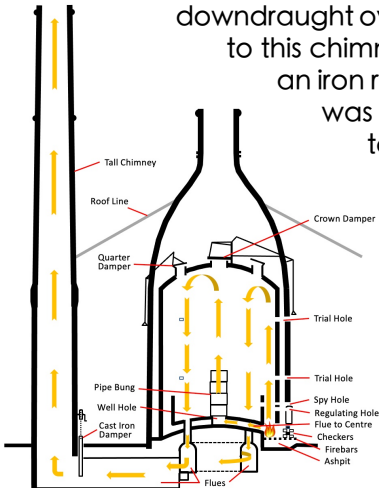

DOWNDRAUGHT OVEN WITH SEPARATE CHIMNEY

This type of bottle oven is constructed with a receiving well or chamber underneath the firing chamber floor into which the downdraught flues ran. From this chamber a main flue was connected to a tall chimney standing separately from the oven. This chimney could be connected and used in common by several downdraught ovens. The main flue to this chimney was fitted with an iron regulator door that was opened or closed to control the draught.



As the temperature rose the crown damper was closed and the regulator door in the flue to the outside chimney was opened.
